Expansion of Recall Notice: Ground Turkey Products

Cargill Meat Solutions Corporation is recalling approximately **185,000 pounds of ground turkey products** that may be contaminated with a multi-drug resistant strain of Salmonella Heidelberg. This is the same strain that initiated the August 2011 recall of ground turkey products. The newly recalled products include the brand names of *Honeysuckle*, *HEB* and *Kroger*. The products subject to recall bear the establishment number "P-963" inside the USDA mark of inspection and a "use or freeze by" date beginning September 10, 2011 through the end of September 2011.

There is a possibility that affected products may have been included in the following:

MEA1076: Description: Meat, Assorted 30lb. Repack.

MEA9887: Description: Meat Assorted Repack (items under 4 lbs. each)

MEA9888: Description: Meat Assorted Repack (items over 4 lbs. each)

If your agency has received any of the affected products, please stop using this product and throw it away immediately.
