Federal cuts could leave us with 1.5 million fewer pounds of food in 2025. The state budget has not yet been approved, but as written, it could result in an additional 1.5 million fewer pounds of food for our food bank.

This deficit in government food represents approximately 7% of our total distribution, and would significantly impact our region.

Recent government funding cuts have impacted both food and funding availability for your Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank.
