Inflation and reduced federal food benefits through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) continue to drive families to the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank's hunger-relief network. There are more visits to food programs within our network now than during the pandemic.

Though more people are in need, there's simply not enough surplus food being donated to the Foodbank to keep pace with the demand. Our inventory turnover is 100% - we are distributing 100% of the food that is brought in on a monthly basis.
