

For the fourth consecutive year, your Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank served more neighbors and distributed more food than the previous year.

In partnership with our hunger-relief network, we provided access to enough food for 32.8 million meals in 2025 — now the largest year in the organization's history.

The government shutdown and delayed distribution of food benefits caused a significant surge in demand across our region. Though we experienced a nearly 30% decrease in food support from federal and state sources, we extended our pantry hours and sent our mobile pop-up pantry into additional neighborhoods to serve our community in a time of great need.
