SCHOOL'S OUT

What does this mean for those who rely on school meals?

More than 680,000 children in Ohio qualify for free or reduced-price meals during the school year. For many of these children, school meals mean consistent access to nourishing foods.

Marie Senften-Deitz, the director of Canton Calvary Mission, knows this problem all too well.

"As the number of children living in poverty in the area continues to grow, our program has continued to grow as well," said Marie.

"There is no reason for any child to be hungry, especially in our neighborhood."

Every day during the summer, Marie, the Mission staff and their team of volunteers, will host up to 180 children for breakfast and lunch, like Austin.

Austin's dad is a landscaper, but he has been out of work while awaiting back surgery. Even with Austin's mom working to clean homes, their family still struggles to make ends meet during the month.

At the lunch program, Austin will receive a nutritionally sound, healthy meal, with the menu geared to children and teens. And as a bonus, Austin can participate in activities at the Mission like a gardening project or playing basketball with other kids from his community.

ARE FOOD BANKS & FOOD PANTRIES THE SAME THING?

The term food bank has been used interchangeably with the term food pantry for years, but as America's food bank system has grown over the years, they have come to mean different things.

At the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank, we solicit, store and distribute food and other essential items to member agency programs in eight Northeast Ohio counties. These member agency programs operate 500 food pantries, hot meal sites, shelters and other hunger-relief programs in the neighborhoods and communities where people need food.

The Foodbank is the storehouse for millions of pounds of food and other products that get distributed to member agency programs like food pantries. The pantry functions as the arms that reach out to that community directly.

Food banks and food pantries are different but share the same commitment.

We are proud of our partnership with food pantries—and many other organizations—that act with us to serve those in need.
