As we reflect on the past quarter, it's clear that local families are struggling — the need for help with groceries is at an all-time high. We estimate that more than 3 million visits will be made to our hunger-relief network by the end of the year, 1 million more visits than in 2020 during the pandemic.

Because of your generosity, the Foodbank has increased the amount of food it has distributed by 16%. Our

mobile pop-up pantry has served more people with more food this year compared to last year. And the Keith D. Monda Family Food Pantry in our Stark County Campus has distributed nearly 800,000 pounds of food so far this year, up 101%. Together, we can help create a season filled with kindness, warmth and nourishing meals.
